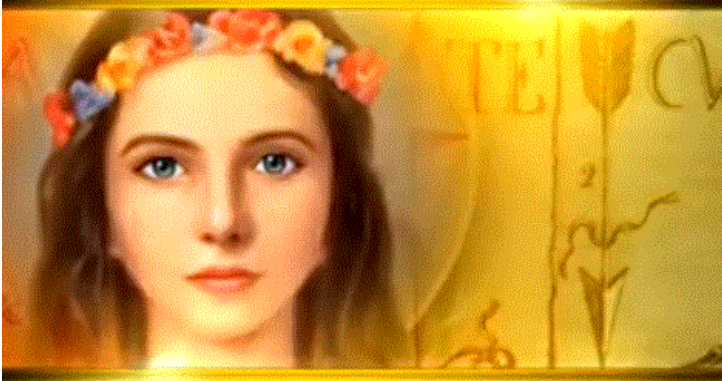

## ¿Es Usted un Feligrés en Buenos Términos?

Nuestra parroquia está comprometida en apoyar a usted y a su familia en su jornada de fe. Mantener los edificios y terrenos en el campus de nuestra parroquia y pagar los salarios del personal que aquí trabaja duro y lucha por proporcionar el amplio espectro de ministerios litúrgico, catequético y pastoral que componen la tela de nuestra comunidad parroquial, requiere de su continuo y generoso apoyo financiero. Nuestra parroquia no recibe ayuda financiera de fuera. Así, en el espíritu de buena participación, por favor comprendan su necesidad de mantener a su parroquia comprometiéndose a ser un FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS.

La posición de un FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS es mantenido si, una persona/familia:

1. (a) Ha asistido a Misa regularmente y usado los sobres de contribución los Domingos y otros Santos Días de Obligación por los últimos cuatro meses, o  
(b) Ha asistido a Misa regularmente los Domingos y otros Santos Días de Obligación por los últimos cuatro meses y está inscritos en Parish Pay (donativo electrónico).
2. Notifica a la oficina de la parroquia de cualquier cambio a su domicilio, número telefónico, correo electrónico, estado marital o información sobre nacimientos/defunciones.

Si usted o un miembro de su familia fue un FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS en el pasado, esto no necesariamente lo hace un FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS ahora. Además, simplemente llenando una forma de inscripción y asistiendo a Misa regularmente (o declarar hacerlo) no es criterio suficiente para ser considerado un FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS.

La posición de FELIGRÉS EN BUENOS TÉRMINOS es necesaria para lo siguiente:

1. Estar disponible para el privilegio de servir como Padrino o patrocinador.
2. Para aquellos buscando los Sacramentos de Iniciación (Bautismo, Confirmación y Primera Comunión) para niños y Adultos.
3. Para parejas buscando Preparación para el Matrimonio.
4. Para aquellos buscando la cuota de miembros para la educación religiosa y honorarios para matrimonios y funerales.
5. Para aquellos buscando la aprobación del Párroco para que se les otorgue matrícula reducida en alguna de las Escuelas Diocesanas.
6. Para que se les otorgue el privilegio de una Misa especial, tal como la celebración de Aniversarios, y como el primer paso buscando la celebración para Quinceañera.
7. Para aquellos que buscan ayuda de la parroquia con el procedimiento de inmigración.

Muchas gracias por su comprensión y apreciación sobre la necesidad de un criterio en esta área que es objetivo y medible. Si usted tiene preguntas, primero hable con Dios (rece) y luego si es necesario, hable con el Párroco.

## Are you a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING?

Our parish is very committed to supporting you and your family in your journey of faith. Maintaining the buildings and grounds on our parish campus and providing for the salaries of the hard-working staff here who strive to provide the full array of liturgical, catechetical, and pastoral ministries that build up the fabric of our parish community requires your generous ongoing financial support. Our parish receives no outside financial assistance. And so, in the spirit of good stewardship, please understand your need to support your parish by committing to being a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING.

Being a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING is maintained if, a person/family:

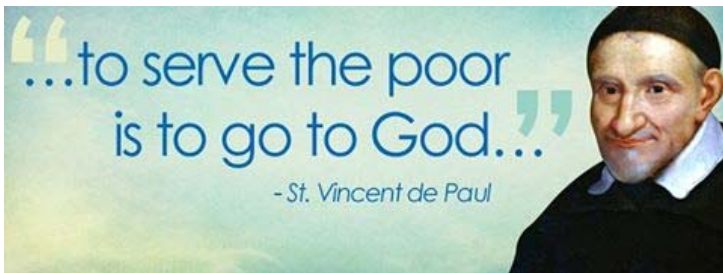
1. (a) Has attended Mass and used the contribution envelopes regularly on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation for the past four months, or  
(b) Has attended Mass regularly on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation over the past four months and be enrolled in Parish Pay (electronic giving).
2. Notifies the parish office of any changes to your address, phone number, email, marital status or birth/death information.

If you or a member of your family were a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING in the past, this does not necessarily make you a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING now. Additionally, simply filling out a registration form and attending Mass regularly (or claiming to) are not sufficient criteria to be considered a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING.

Being a PARISHIONER IN GOOD STANDING is required for the following:

1. To be granted for the privilege of serving as Godparent or sponsor.
2. For those seeking the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion) for children or adults.
3. For couples seeking Marriage Preparation.
4. For those seeking the in-parish rate for religious Education fees, and wedding and funeral honorariums.
5. For those seeking the Pastor's approval of being granted reduced tuition status at one of our Diocesan Schools.
6. To be granted the privilege of a special Mass, such as celebration of Anniversaries, and as the first step when seeking a Quinceañera celebration.
7. For those seeking the parish's assistance with immigration proceedings.

Many thanks for your understanding and appreciation of the need for criteria in this area that are objective and measurable. If you have questions, first please talk with God (pray!), and then if necessary, talk with the Pastor.



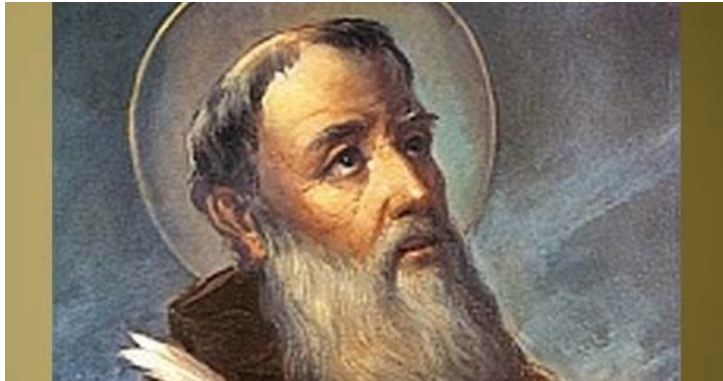
Thanks to all your generosity, the St. Vincent de Paul volunteers have provided the following to the needy in our parish boundary;

Report from April 1 through June 30, 2017; \$14,695 for shelter, transportation, utilities, food and personal hygiene products that we needed to purchase for the pantry. This also includes assisting to purchase a washing machine and household items from our thrift store for someone who had nothing and air bed mattresses.

We made 115 home visits and 4 visits to motel or parking lot to assist those who needed shelter for a night.

With your contributions, we were able to assist and contact 323 people, including children.
