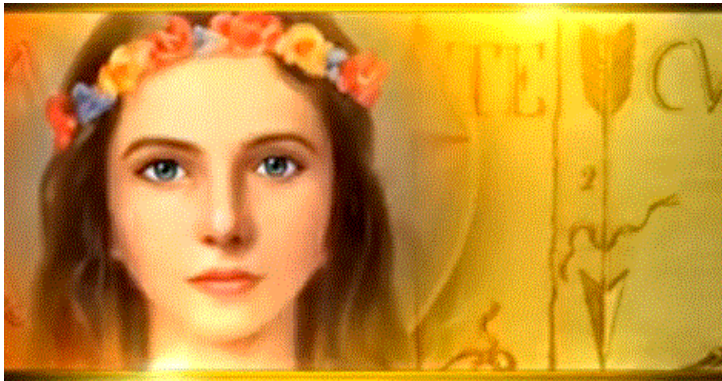

Report from April 1 through June 30, 2017;
\$14,695 for shelter, transportation, utilities, food and personal hygiene products that we needed to purchase for the pantry. This also includes assisting to purchase a washing machine and household items from our thrift store for someone who had nothing and air bed mattresses.

We made 115 home visits and 4 visits to motel or parking lot to assist those who needed shelter for a night.

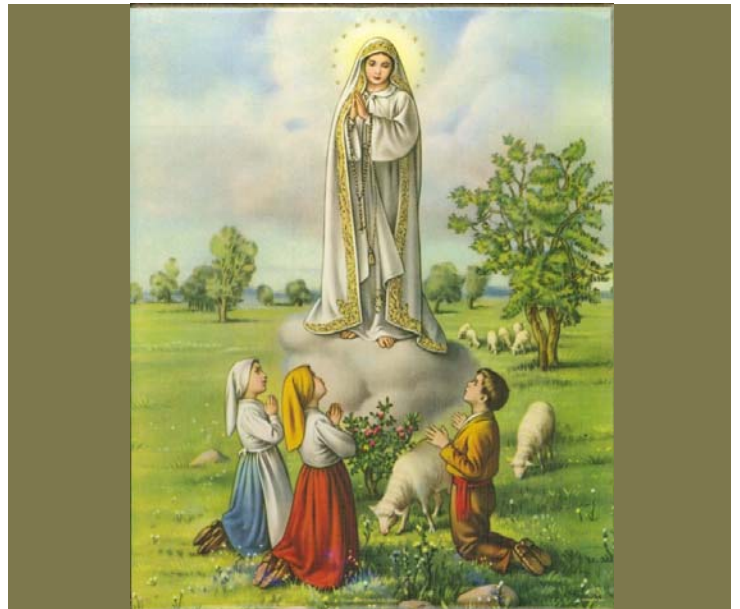
