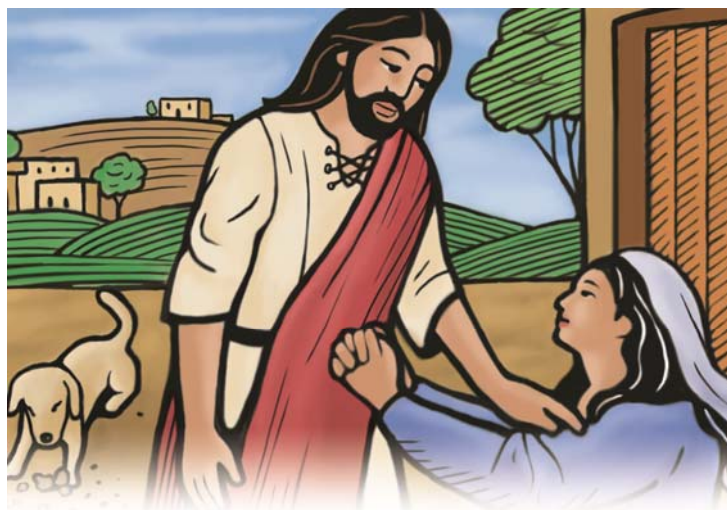

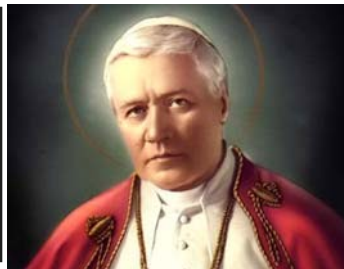

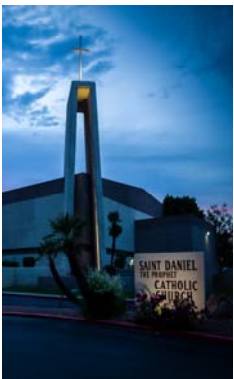

Preserving Human Dignity through Virtue

As a parish within the Diocese of Phoenix, we regularly present a program for all new employees and volunteers titled Called to Protect for Ministries. In this program you will learn myths and facts about sexual abuse and sexual offenders, detailed warning signs to watch for in adults who may abuse, and how to identify children who may have been abused. You will also learn specific steps to take in screening and guidelines for interaction, monitoring, training and responding.

This interactive program is mandatory for all employees, and volunteers that serve within the Diocese of Phoenix. Due to the sensitive nature of the topic no one under 18 years old is permitted to attend this session. You may register for this workshop online at

safeenvironmenttraining.org/classes.php.

At the workshop, you will be asked to sign a Code of Ethics based on the diocese's Policy and Procedures for the Protection of Minors. Please take a moment to review the policy by visiting the [safe environment](http://safeenvironment.org) page for the Diocese of Phoenix.

You will also be asked to complete a diocesan volunteer application. Please plan to bring a list of your previous volunteer experience, with the name and contact information for your volunteer supervisors, as well as contact information (name, address, and phone number) for at least three references (one professional, one personal, and one family member).
